Trusting Yourself

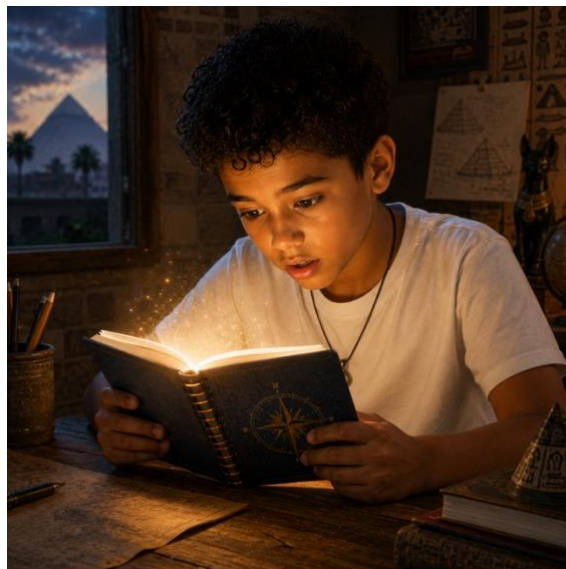
Discussion Questions:
